Are you involved with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Canada: CIBC's Youthvision Scholarship Program. CIBC Youthvision scholarships are awarded annually to 30 students in Grade 10 who are enrolled in a mentoring program with either Big Brothers Big Sisters of Canada or YMCA Canada. Following Grade 11, scholarship recipients can also participate in a summer internship at the YMCA, with a take-home pay of up to \$2,000 per summer while in high school. The total value of the scholarship for each recipient can be up to \$35,000. A former Byrne grad won this scholarship and is still using the funds in her fourth year at University of Toronto!
